

## Terms & Conditions

Please read these terms and conditions before signing this application form

1. The stall fee is non-refundable (under all circumstances). Noor UI Islam cannot be held liable for any costs (incidental or otherwise) arising from situations beyond its control.
2. Each stall holder must occupy the pitch allocated to him/her. We will not be able to swap or move stalls around. In the event this is not complied with then Noor UI Islam reserve the right to ask the stall holder to leave without notice and without refund.
3. Under no circumstances will stall holders be allowed to extend and/or place his/her goods and/or offer his/her services outside the designated boundary of the pitch(es) allocated to him/her. Each pitch area will be 10ft x 10ft. Stall holders may not encroach onto any pitch nor create a disturbance to other stall holders. Noor UI Islam reserves the right to ask any such stall holder to leave the site immediately, without advanced notice and without any reimbursement. Additionally, Noor UI Islam reserves the right to prevent future bookings being made for future events due to the material breach.
4. The size of the table given with each pitch will be 6ft x 2ft (only one). One chair will also be supplied. Additional chairs and tables can be booked for in advance.
5. There will be no provision of electricity at the stalls.
6. Controlled Parking Zones (Resident Parking permit) is in force on local roads on Saturday till 9:00pm. Noor UI Islam will not accept any liability for any parking violations.
7. For the purpose of entry in the event, all stall holders are requested to bring along with them the confirmation letter. The stall number and location will be provided prior to the event. Stall holders will be given only 4 tickets (2 for each day). Additional tickets will need to be purchased if you are bringing more than two persons per stall.
8. All stall holders must ensure that their designated areas and surroundings are left clean before their departure on each day. Please do not leave any broken Gazebos, Chairs etc.
9. Please note the pitch allocated to you will not have any covering (eg gazebos). Therefore, the stall holders have to make their own arrangement.
10. Noor UI Islam reserves the right to refuse applications for bookings without having to give reason, if for example at previous events the terms and conditions were not complied with by the applicant and/or by accompanying helpers on the stall.
11. All stall holders agree to sell or advertise Halaal products only. They must also agree to abide by copyright laws and intellectual property laws (for example but not limited to, software and audio materials). Noor UI Islam reserves the right to carry out random spot checks were deemed necessary.
12. Any stall holders who sells, distributes or displays any literature are providing this on the pretext that Noor UI Islam is not associated with this and this must be readily

advised to all customers. Any literature promoting hatred, vulgarity and un-Islamic principles are not permitted on site, and in the event any such information is found on site then Noor UI Islam reserves the right to ask any such stall holder to leave the site immediately, without advanced notice and without any reimbursement.

Additionally, Noor UI Islam reserves the right to prevent future bookings being made for future events due to the material breach.

13. No prohibited or offensive items can be sold or displayed including Pellet guns, Air rifles, knives and swords. In the event of any such items are found on site then Noor UI Islam reserves the right to ask any such stall holder to leave the site immediately, without advanced notice and without any reimbursement. Additionally, Noor UI Islam reserves the right to prevent future bookings being made for future events due to the material breach.
14. All stall holders and their guests present on the day must adhere to Islamic (modest) dress rules and behaviour.
15. You will be expected to arrive to set up by 9:30am. You are allowed to keep one reasonably sized car or van behind your stalls. (No trucks or large vehicles). You will have to remove your vehicles off site from between 7:30pm and 8:30pm. Vehicles cannot be taken in or out of the site between 9:30am and 7:30pm.
16. Vehicles can only be driven at 5mph or less on the grounds.
17. We will be only allowing businesses and charities to book stalls (e.g. no ideological / political / canvassing stalls)
18. Stall holders must abide by Safety and Emergency procedures that will be provided to them
19. Items left on site overnight is at owner's risk.
